Newcomer Employment Services for Adults (NESA) offers a variety of services to enhance understanding of the Canadian labour market work culture. Employment Coaches assist newcomers, pre-arrival and after arrival, to successfully apply their skills in the Canadian work force.

- Develop a return-to-work action plan
- Create a professional Canadian style resume and cover letter
- Learn job search techniques, practice interview skills, and understand the Canadian job market
- Find and apply for job opportunities
- Seek informational interviews with potential employers
- Explore further training options to meet short and long term employment goals
- Become an independent job seeker
- A **Foreign Qualification Recognition Pathways** specialist will assist professionals to:
 - Navigate pathways to licensure in your field
 - Access professional mentorship
 - Apply for financial support through the Atlantic Immigrant Career Loan Fund (AICLF)



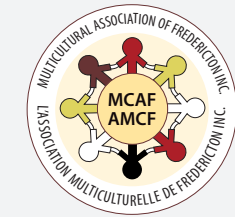
- **Pre EmployMe** workshops, training and tools focus on building strong resumes, interview skills and networks:
 - employment & networking opportunities
 - career information and recruitment sessions
 - occupation specific bridging programs
 - skills enhancement training including:
 - First Aid and CPR
 - Food Safety Certification
 - Workplace Essential Skills Training (WES)
 - PLAR, CCT
- the **Newcomer Computer Learning Centre** (NCLC) offers free access to computers for job search and resume preparation.
- **Portfolio Development** (PLAR) allows newcomers to demonstrate and communicate previous employment experience to Canadian employers, regulatory bodies and educational institutions.

- **Professional Mentorship** connects you with a mentor from your desired profession. Mentors provide professional advice, networking and support.
- **Foreign Qualification Recognition** (FQR) promotes the fair and accurate recognition of qualification and skills of immigrants by regulatory organizations and employers.
- **Atlantic Immigrant Career Loan Fund** (AICLF) provides micro loans to assist internationally trained immigrants to overcome financial barriers to becoming licensed to practice in Canada.
- **Cultural Competency Training** (CCT) is instruction to achieve cultural competence and the ability to appreciate and interpret accurately other cultures, allowing for richer relationships.
