- Excellent interpersonal, communication skills and proven ability to connect with children
- Ability to show empathy and care
- Flexible, patient, and interested in helping children
- Reliable, trustworthy, and outgoing
- Strong group facilitation skills with ability to lead large and small group activities
- Strong ability to work in team and independently
- Ability to thrive in a dynamic environment
- Cross-cultural awareness and experience in a multicultural environment
- Proven ability to work well under pressure
- Good organizational and planning skills

Physical Requirements

- The job involves working with young children and includes lifting and participating in physical activities. It may also involve the supervision of children and physical activities.

Terms of employment:

This position is funded under Employment and Social Development Canada, Canada Summer Jobs. Applicants **must meet all of the following requirements:**

- Be between 15 and 30 years of age at the start of employment;
- Be a Canadian Citizen, permanent resident, or person on whom refugee protection has been conferred under the Immigration and Refugee Protection Act and
- Be legally entitled to work according to the relevant provincial/ territorial legislation and regulations

- Contract – 8-week summer contract
- Valid First Aid Certification and CPR
- Criminal Record Check Clearance with Vulnerable Sector
- Social Development record check
